Minimising Cancer and Maximising Lives since 1964, Singapore Cancer Society (SCS) is a self-funded social service agency which provides an integrated continuum of care from cancer control and prevention to patient support services, survivorship, and palliative care. SCS's key programmes and services include cancer screening programmes, public education, financial and welfare services, psychosocial support, survivorship care, rehabilitation programmes and hospice care. Consistently recognised for its commitment to high standards in governance and transparency, SCS has attained both the coveted Charity Governance Award (2023) and the Charity Transparency Award for four years, between 2019 to 2024.

The Singapore Cancer Society organises various fundraising activities, including Relay For Life, to rally the community to join in the fight, raising funds to support quality services for cancer patients, survivors, their families, and the wider community.

Every year, we need to raise \$\$20 million to fund our programmes and services. Through the Relay For Life 2025, we aim to fundraise \$1,300,000 to support the various services that benefit the cancer community including cancer prevention and control, patient support, financial assistance, rehabilitation, survivorship, and palliative care.

ABOUT

Relay For Life (RFL) is a global movement founded in May 1985 by American Cancer Society in Tacoma, Washington. Since then, it has grown into a worldwide phenomenon, raising about US\$5 billion to fight cancer. Close to 4 million participants take part in RFL across the globe annually, making it one of the world's largest fundraisers.

Singapore is the 25th member country to organise RFL. Singapore Cancer Society (SCS) aims to rally the local community to celebrate the lives of those who battled cancer, remember loved ones lost, and fight back against a disease that has taken many lives. It is also an excellent platform for cancer survivors, caregivers, and volunteers to be recognised, supported, and connected via a strong support system.

With a target outreach of 6,000 participants, this community event also seeks to raise \$1,300,000 to fund various SCS programmes and services. To accomplish the objectives of Celebrate, Remember and Fight Back, RFL has three special segments during the event to express the importance of cancer journey.

ADDRESS: 1 Stadium Drive, Singapore 397629



- Take Bus Service 11. Alight along Stadium Crescent (Bus Stop No. 80199), which is directly outside Singapore Indoor Stadium.
- Take Bus Service 10, 14, 16, 70, 70M OR 196. Alight along Nicoll Highway (Bus Stop No. 80219) or (Bus Stop No. 80211).



- Stadium MRT Station (CC6) is the nearest MRT station
- Exit Stadium MRT via Exit A and take the escalator up to Level 3 of Sports Hub and you will reach Gate 3 (Participant entrance)
- Kallang MRT Station (EW10) is approximately 600m walking distance under a sheltered walkway to the Singapore Sports Hub




- Guests are advised to park at *Carpark B (Lot B11-B13) located along Stadium Drive, which is nearest to registration
- Guests can take either the escalator / lift to Level 3 of Sports Hub and look for Gate 3




Event Site Map

- * All participants should register at Gate 3 of the National Stadium and collect their coloured wrist tags.
- * Spectators are welcome inside the Stadium, but please note that access to the running track is restricted.
- * After registration, Team Leaders or a representative can head to the Baton Collection Booth inside the Stadium to pick up the team's baton.
- * For security reasons, bag checks will be conducted for everyone entering the Stadium.

- ✓ Individual participants or one team representative to report to the 100KM Challenge booth at least 30 minutes before the event flag-off to collect your tracker or baton.
- ✓ Each Relay Champion will receive the 100KM Finisher tee at the 100KM booth after completing the 100KM distance after 9am.



Luminaria bags will be laid out on frames at a gallery during the Luminaria Ceremony!




The medical point will be located at the East and West Entrance. The ambulance service will be located at the East Entrance.

The ambulance team will act as frontline emergency staff and respond to all emergencies, triage medical needs and decide if the situation requires evacuation to a hospital.



Evacuation

Singapore Cancer Society – TalkMed Relay For Life



- 1. In the event of evacuation, Sports Hub Security will inform everyone about the evacuation.
- 2. Giant screen and speakers around the national stadium will give a generic broadcast asking patrons to leave the stadium.
- 3. Usher/CSO/Staffs will guide all participants out of the stadium in a calm and orderly manner.
- 4. All participants should gather at Kallang Practice Track (opposite OCBC arena, across the road)
